Hospital Information

- A. Pre-registration
 - a. Check in at admissions usually off the main lobby of the hospital.
 - b. Consents for treatment need to be signed for you and your baby.
- B. Entrance into the Hospital
 - a. Check for the times the lobby is open and find out where the Labor and Delivery/maternity unit is located.
 - b. If after normal lobby hours you may need to enter through the Emergency Room.
- C. Visiting Hours:
 - a. The Labor and Delivery unit is open 24/7
 - b. People visiting will need to be given instructions on your wishes for them. There may also be restrictions on who and when they can visit while you are in labor.
 - c. Siblings may visit as long as they are well.
 - d. Check when the general visiting hours are for the maternity unit.
- D. Pediatrician
 - a. Before you deliver your baby, you should find out who you want to care for your baby. There area pediatricians at Ohio Health who will care for the baby but you will need to know who you plan to take the baby to after discharge.
 - b. You may need to decide depending on your insurance network for approved providers.
 - c. If you do not have one before you deliver, the hospital will make arrangements for you.
- E. Tours
 - a. Check to see if the hospital you plan to deliver at has tours for you
 - b. Also check if they offer a tour for the siblings- designed to alleviate your child's fears of separation.
