## Upon Arrival to the Hospital Labor vs. Observation

- Brief verbal assessment then you will be in an observation or birthing room.
- Exam (internal) to determine Dilation- Effacement- Station
- External fetal monitor to assess fetal heart waves (TOCO)
- Internal fetal monitor- after bag of water ruptures is more accurate heart pattern.
- Observation: 1-3 hours to monitor cervical dilation changes
- Active Labor: Cervical changes, membranes are ruptured either spontaneously or manually.
- IV and medications will be considered.
